Rex Melton's Cherry Lumber

Rex Melton's family has donated some of his lumber, all cherry, to the School of Forest Resources. The lumber comes from trees that were cut from Rex's property in order to build his home.

The lumber has been planed to two thicknesses, 3/8" and 7/8". A few pieces are a different thickness. The 3/8"-boards are 4 to 5 feet long, and 4 to 6 inches wide. There are approximately 30 pieces of lumber this size. The 7/8"-boards are 4 to 8 feet long. Most pieces are 4 to 6 inches wide. There are more than 20 pieces of lumber this size. Some of the boards are entirely heartwood, some include sapwood, and some include both. There is plenty of clear lumber and some lumber with defects.

In exchange for any or all of the lumber, we ask that you make a donation to either the Rex Melton Memorial Fund at Shaver's Creek or to the School of Forest Resources Alumni Fund for Teaching Excellence.

The lumber is stored in the Forest Resources Lab at University Park and will be available for inspection on Friday afternoon, April 15, 1:30 - 4:30 p.m. Please contact Mr. Mike Powell at 814-863-1113 or mjp175@psu.edu if you have questions about the lumber or if you want to arrange an alternate time to see the lumber.
