

Bird Banding & Bird Walk FALL 2019 SCHEDULE



BANDING:

All banding will take place at a new site located along the edge of Hartley Wood and the adjacent field, 300 yards NW of the Arboretum's Overlook

Pavilion. Ending time of 11:00 am is approximate. Sessions will be canceled with rain or constant winds above 20 mph.

WALKS: All bird walks begin at the Arboretum's parking lot except for the walk on October 3.* Wear sturdy shoes for walking on wet ground and bring a pair of binoculars if you have them. All levels of experience are welcome. Walks will be cancelled with steady rain.
