"WILDLIFE FACT FILE" GUIDELINES

- 1. Each student must pick a different "animal" (first come, first served)
- 2. "Animal" includes mammals, fish, insects, reptiles, amphibians
- 3. The animal does not have to live only in your state or be native to the state, as long as it is currently living in the wild in your state/region/country
- 4. At least 3 different resources must be used to find the information listed on the "Wildlife Fact File" sheet
- 5. Information on the fact file sheet must be written in complete sentences in your neatest handwriting
- 6. You will be given time in class to do research and complete this assignment, but you may also work on it at home
- 7. The completed fact file sheet is due two weeks from today
- 8. You will present your animal to the class shortly after the due date
- 9. You will be graded on content, editing, neatness, and effort
