

Handout #3 – Student Instructions for Digital Photography Project

FIELD:

1. Using what we learned about the lifecycle of the tree, find examples of each of the stages of development.
2. Take turns collecting images on the digital camera. Remember it is ok to take more than one image of the various stages, as you can edit the pictures inside later.
3. Remember to consider the keys to a good photograph including: composition, light, balance, background and the rule of thirds.

CLASSROOM:

Your assignment is to take your photographs and create an interesting multimedia presentation which connects the lifecycle of a tree to the lifecycle of man. Be certain to crop your photographs and add titles and subtitles to make your presentation interesting. You can also add music and images from your initial work on The Seven Ages of Man.
