Reasons for Endangerment

Market hunting—We saw the loss of the passenger pigeon in our country and the loss of the buffalo all in the name of market hunting and greed

Pet Trade—the pet trade has created a tremendous demand for exotic animals such as monkeys and parrots.

Medicinal/cultural—tusks of Rhinos as dagger handles and aphrodisiacs, and health remedies with Tiger bones.

Introduction of exotic diseases—American chestnut blight was accidentally introduced from Europe and wiped out the greatest food source for wildlife in the east.

Pesticides—DDT and the birds of prey, the eagle and the Peregrine Falcon

Genetic Inbreeding—red wolf and the coyote

Intrinsic Characteristics—low reproductive rate, restrictive range, low abundance, large size, conspicuous behavior (Elephant)

Predator and Pest Control-killing what competed with man's

interests (wolf)

Habitat destruction—greatest reason for species loss rain forest, wetlands, coral reefs, and fragmentation
