Compost	A mixture of decayed or decaying organic matter used to fertilize soil. Compost is usually made by gathering plant material, such as leaves, grass clippings, and vegetable peels, into a pile or bin and letting it decompose as a result of the action of aerobic bacteria, fungi, and other organisms.
Dew	Water droplets condensed from the air, usually at night, onto cool surfaces near the ground. Dew forms when the temperature of the surfaces falls below the dew point of the surrounding air.
Ordinance	An authoritative rule or law; a decree or command. A public regulation.
Vegetation	Plants of an area or a region; plant life
Evaporation	The change of a liquid into a vapor at a temperature below the boiling point.
Ventilation	The act or process of providing a fresh air supply.
Flammable	Burnable, ignitable
